## Certified Home Health Aide Academy

Candidates will be hired as full-time home health aide intern employees. At the end of the program, students will be hired as home health aides for the Capital Health LIFE and Capital Health Assisted Living programs. The Certified Home Health Aide Academy (CHHA) consists of a five-week training program (40 hours per week) with 16 hours of clinical training throughout. To advance to the CHHA resident position, candidates must pass the CHHA certification test within two attempts. Upon certification, candidates will move into full-time positions as a certified home health aides with Capital Health ALP or LIFE. **High School graduate or equivalent required.**



**EXPERIENCE:** Patient care experience preferred.

**OTHER CREDENTIALS:** Must possess a valid driver's license, in good standing. Must complete American Heart Association Heartsaver course before end of orientation period.

**KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS:** Must have basic computer knowledge. Possesses a friendly demeanor and excellent customer service skills.

**MENTAL, BEHAVIORAL AND EMOTIONAL ABILITIES:** Must have excellent listening skills and attention to detail. Develops strong interpersonal relationships with coworkers and resident base.

**USUAL WORK DAY:** Full-time employment. 8 hours a day.

Capital Health Certified Home Health Aide Academy is made possible through a partnership with Berkel Training Institute in Trenton, New Jersey. This program follows the New Jersey State curriculum for Unlicensed Assistive Personnel, managed by the New Jersey Board of Nursing with a focus in home health care.
